#### RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY

- Plastics #1- #7
- Metals
- Clear and colored glass
- Paper
- Boxboard (flat)
- Cardboard (corrugated)
- Polystyrene foam
- Cooking oil
- Ink cartridges
- CFL bulbs
- Phone books
- Cell Phones
- Household batteries (please tape over the circuits on lithium, 9-volt, and larger batteries)

## RECYCLING TIP OF THE MONTH

#### CAN BOOKS BE RECYCLED?

If the book is still in good condition, try donating it! Schools, places of faith, charities, and non-profits will often accept book donations. If the book is not in usable condition, it can be recycled. Paperback



books can be recycled as-is; remove the cover from a hardcover book before recycling it.

#### ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Plastic containers that contain hazardous waste (motor oil or anti-freeze)
- Pop or beer box containers
- Containers designed to go in the freezer or refrigerator
- Plastic bags
- Construction foam
- Dishwashers (unless stripped down)
- Propane tanks
- Syringes
- Plastic silverware, plates, or straws
- Aerosol cans
- Disposable coffee cups (non-Styrofoam)
- Plastic hangers
- Plastic oxygen hoses
- Paint cans
- Packing Peanuts
- String and/or twine
- Toys
- E-cigarettes / vapes

#### METAL COLLECTION

## ALL ITEMS MUST BE 80% METAL OR MORE TO BE ACCEPTED.

(e.g. washers/dryers, stoves, water heaters & softeners, furnaces, metal lawn furniture, lawn mowers (no fluids), rototillers, weed whackers, pots/pans, grills, basketball poles (no cement), metal fence, cabinets, metal yard ornaments, clean burning barrels, steel doors (no glass), cast iron, metal sinks, etc.)

Metal collection is available year-round at no cost.

#### From Saginaw Highway:

Take Elmwood Road South by Meijer. Elmwood becomes Snow Road. Continue south past Mt. Hope Highway. Turn right on Pierson Highway. Turn left on Sanders Road Sanders Road ends at Millett Highway where the Recycling Center is located.

#### From Waverly Road:

Travel south on Waverly Road to Lansing Road. Travel west on Lansing Road to Millett Highway. The Recycling Center is located just across. Millett Highway and the railroad. Please note: Millett Highway does not travel between Canal and Creyts Road due to the Meijer Distribution Center. You must enter the recycling center either from Snow Road or Old Lansing Road.
