



CHECKING FOR LEAKS



Leak Detection

- Turn all water-using appliances off so water is not being used anywhere in the house. Check the position of the meter dial and wait. If after 15 minutes, the dials have not moved - congratulations! You have a relatively water-tight home.
- If the dials have moved, begin checking hose connections, faucets and toilets for water leaks. If everything is turned off and it is certain the toilets and connections are not leaking but, the dial is still turning, it is possible there could be a hidden leak. A plumber may need to be contacted for assistance with this problem.

Sprinkler Usage

- Read your meter before sprinkler is used. Then turn on sprinkler and monitor the meter dial while it moves for two minutes. Take an estimate as to how long your sprinkler usually runs. This high amount of water usage used for watering your gardens/lawns may surprise you.
