
SOFTBALL DIAMOND PRACTICE RESERVATION POLICY

1. The Parks and Recreation Department will only accept ball diamond reservations from teams playing in the current Delta Township Parks and Recreation adult softball and kickball leagues. Reservations must be made by the Team Manager. Team name and league will be required when booking.
2. All diamonds must be reserved through the Delta Township Parks and Recreation Department Office. Hours: 8 a.m.–5 p.m., Monday–Friday. Phone: 323-8555.
3. Diamonds may be reserved up to two weeks in advance. Practice reservations will be issued on a first come, first served basis.
4. Teams may reserve only ONE practice session per week with the week running Sunday through Saturday.
5. Diamond Practice Reservation Permits are issued for all practice sessions and are emailed to teams as a reservation confirmation.
6. Time slots for reservations are as follows:
 - Monday through Friday:
5–7 p.m. OR 7–9 p.m.
 - Saturday and Sunday:
9–11 a.m., 11 a.m.–1 p.m., 1–3 p.m., 3–5 p.m., 5–7 p.m., and 7–9 p.m..
7. The diamonds will be available without reservation on a first come, first served basis on weekdays before 5 p.m. This excludes those diamonds which have been prepared for league or tournament play.
8. Bases and lines are not provided with practice reservations.

The Delta Township Parks and Recreation Department will make every effort to make the diamonds available for practice by the first week in April. Field playability is largely dependent upon the weather. When fields are deemed unplayable by this department TEAMS MUST STAY OFF THE ENTIRE FIELD. Any team found ignoring this request will not be allowed to make reservations for the remainder of the year.
