



## Bat Testing

Bat testing will be required for ALL leagues:

To play in a Delta Township adult softball league your bat must be **BOTH**:

- On the ASA Certified Bat List
- Tested by the Delta Township Parks and Recreation Department and have a hologram sticker

Delta Township Parks and Recreation By-Law States:

1. Bat Testing (Refer to [www.asasoftball.com](http://www.asasoftball.com) for the banned bat list.)
  - a. Testing Information
    - i. All bats must be ASA approved and must have the ASA logo.
    - ii. All bats must be tested and have the league hologram sticker affixed to the bat.
    - iii. Bats may be spot tested at any time throughout the season by a Parks and Recreation office staff member.
  - b. Penalty
    - i. Before the game: Any bat deemed illegal, altered or without a hologram, cannot be used and must be removed from the team area.
    - ii. Using a bat without the hologram sticker, will result in an out, an ejection and a one game suspension.

*\*A separate hologram will be used for Qualifying and State Tournaments.*
