



Bat Testing

Bat testing will be required for ALL leagues:

Bat Testing Schedule:		
Date	Time	Place
<u>Beginning April 1st</u> Monday – Friday	8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.	Delta Admin Bldg. Parks & Recreation Office
Wednesday, April 23 rd	5:00-6:00 p.m. (prior to Manager's Meeting)	

To play in a Delta Township adult softball league your bat must be **BOTH**:

- On the ASA Certified Bat List
- Tested by the Delta Township Parks and Recreation Department and have a 2014 hologram sticker

Delta Township Parks and Recreation By-Law States:

1. Bat Testing (Refer to www.asasoftball.com for the banned bat list.)
 - a. Testing Information
 - i. All bats must be ASA approved and must have the ASA logo.
 - ii. All bats must be tested and have the league hologram sticker affixed to the bat.
 - iii. Bats may be spot tested at any time throughout the season by a Parks and Recreation office staff member.
 - b. Penalty
 - i. Before the game: Any bat deemed illegal, altered or without a hologram, cannot be used and must be removed from the team area.
 - ii. Using a bat without the hologram sticker, will result in an out, an ejection and a one game suspension.

**A separate hologram will be used for Qualifying and State Tournaments.*
