

Delta Township Compiled Policy Manual

Title:	Paving of Gravel Roads Policy

General Purpose: To define the Charter Township of Delta's possible contribution for road paving within the Township.

Summary Statement of Policy: If a petition meets the Eaton County Road Commission's standards for a valid petition, the Township may/will match the Eaton County Road Commission cash contribution to valid petitions for Special Assessment Districts for the purposes of a road paving project of up to 25% of the total project cost.

Actual Policy as Written: A citizen request for road paving matching funds from Delta Township will be eligible for consideration based upon the following criteria:

1. Only those roads that are public roads as of November 1, 2000, shall be eligible for consideration for matching funding from the Charter Township of Delta.
2. The petition meets the Eaton County Road Commission standards for a valid petition including that 75% of the parcels along said road have been split into parcels with frontage of 300' or less or that there is a dwelling unit for each 300' of road frontage.
3. The Township may/will match the Eaton County Road Commission cash contribution to valid petitions for Special Assessment Districts for the purpose of a road paving project up to 25% of the total project cost.
4. The Township may/will commit on a 3-year payment schedule up to an annual liability of \$75,000 toward road paving projects.
5. The Charter Township of Delta Board of Trustees will consider from citizens that have circulate and submitted petitions to the Eaton County Road Commission. Such a petition shall be determined by the Eaton County Road Commission to be valid petitions eligible for a Special Assessment District prior to requesting funds from the Charter Township of Delta. The valid petitions will be considered for matching funds from the Township in the order in which they were received.
6. Projects considered by the Charter Township of Delta Board of Trustees for match by July of one year will be included in the following year's budget proposal. Projects considered after July of one year will be considered for matching funds in the budget proposal two years hence.

7. Border roads including Eaton Highway, Davis Highway and Royston Road will be eligible for up to 12.5% of the total project costs as a Charter Township of Delta match, only if the neighboring communities of Watertown Township, Windsor Township or Oneida Township also contribute 12.5%. The Charter Township of Delta's contribution will be contingent upon the Eaton County Road Commission and/or Clinton County Road Commission, and the neighboring local unit contribution.
