Title:	Water Service Installation Cost Process

General Purpose: To provide direction on the process of supplying ‘Cost of Installation’ for water installations to existing residences.

Summary Statement of Policy: ‘Cost of Installation’ for water service installation into existing homes and new homes is different and this policy explains that difference.

Actual Policy as written:

For water service installation for existing residential homes where a water main already exists, the Utility Department shall have someone go to the site and give a “Cost of Installation”. This cost would be firm and there would be no extra charges or refunds after installation. This cost would be good for 90 days.

For water service installations for new residential home under construction, the developer shall put down a deposit and then be invoiced or refunded the difference in cost based on actual project costs.

All policies (resolutions) previously adopted concerning residential water service installations, which are in conflict with this policy (resolution), are hereby repealed.
