# Community Awards Reception

2013 DELTA TOWNSHIP

The Delta Township Board is pleased to announce the Eighth Annual Delta Township Community Awards Reception to celebrate the accomplishments of Delta Township businesses and citizens. This year, Delta Township will recognize the nominees and honor the award recipients in each category. In addition, the event also celebrates Delta's finest as the "Pride of Delta" honored guests. This year's 'Pride' guests will be the Saginaw Highway businesses. The reception will be held on **October 30, 2013 at the Lexington Lansing Hotel** in Delta Township.

In keeping with tradition, nominations are being sought in each of the following four categories (please note; the nominee need only meet the criteria listed on the nomination form:

The **Business of the Year Award** will honor selected Delta Township businesses or business persons who have been responsible for exceptional outcomes between and among businesses, governments, and nonprofit organizations; or, have served as a role model for other business; or, have gone above and beyond the scope of business to support and promote Delta Township. The goal is to promote shared community interests and encourage business harmony within the township and amongst entities of the Greater Lansing Region.

The **Citizen of the Year Award** will honor selected individual citizens whose extraordinary contributions go "above and beyond" to enhance the quality of life and general reputation of the township.

The **Community Organization of the Year Award** will honor selected groups or organizations for their dedication in serving and promoting Delta Township through volunteer contributions that has impacted the quality of life in Delta Township, provided leadership over a period of years, thereby contributing to the township's character, and/or made a valuable contribution that has enhanced the quality of life for residents of Delta Township.

The **Young Person of the Year Award** is limited to high school seniors (whether traditional high school or home-schooled) who have made a positive contribution to the community, is an example to their friends, may have excelled in academics, music, arts, athletics, etc., or has successfully faced personal challenges. A scholarship will be awarded to the selected individual.





After the conclusion of the De-Leafing program, yard waste will not be accepted again until the spring of 2014. Delta residents must provide a photo I.D. and a Voter I.D. card, property tax notice or a township water/sewer bill to participate in this program.

There is also a \$25 per application processing fee payable to Delta Township for the acceptance of all passport applications. The Delta Township Clerk's Office will be open on Saturday, September 21, from 8 a.m.-12 p.m. for the acceptance of passport applications.
