The Delta Township Board is pleased to announce the Ninth Annual Delta Township Community Awards Reception to celebrate the accomplishments of Delta Township businesses and citizens. This year, Delta Township will recognize the nominees and honor the award recipients in each category. In addition, the event also celebrates Delta's finest as the "Pride of Delta" honored guests. This year's 'Pride' guests will be the celebration of our neighborhoods in Delta Township. The reception will be held on **Thursday, October 30, 2014 at the Crowne Plaza West Lansing Hotel** in Delta Township.

In keeping with tradition, nominations are being sought in each of the following four categories (please note; the nominee need only meet the criteria listed on the nomination form):

The **Business of the Year Award** will honor selected Delta Township businesses or business persons who have been responsible for exceptional outcomes between and among businesses, governments, and nonprofit organizations; OR, have served as a role model for other business; OR, have gone above and beyond the scope of business to support and promote Delta Township. The goal is to promote shared community interest, and encourage business harmony within the township and amongst entities of the Greater Lansing Region.

The **Citizen of the Year Award** will honor selected individual citizens whose extraordinary contributions go "above and beyond" to enhance the quality of life and general reputation of the township.

The **Community Organization of the Year Award** will honor selected groups or organizations for their dedication in serving and promoting Delta Township through volunteer contributions that has impacted the quality of life in Delta Township, provided leadership over a period of years, thereby contributing to the township's character, and/or made a valuable contribution that has enhanced the quality of life for residents of Delta Township.

The **Young Person of the Year Award** is limited to high school seniors (whether traditional high school or home-schooled) who have made a positive contribution to the community, is an example to their friends, may have excelled

in academics, music, arts, athletics, etc., or has successfully faced personal challenges. A scholarship will be awarded to the selected individual.







Applying for Permits Online

Residents and business owners can now apply for, and have permits issued, online. The application process is a step-by-step procedure, which may be found on the Township website located under the Services Tab in the menu, or on the hot-link on the township homepage AMG (Access My Gov). This service allows you to complete the application process when it's convenient for you, and does not require a visit to the Township Hall. The permit fees are paid using your credit card.

Automated Inspection Hotline

The Inspection Hotline allows contractors and homeowners to schedule the necessary trade inspections online. The user simply locates the permit they need an inspection for, selects the inspection type desired, and the day you need the inspection. Upon submission, the inspection is automatically inserted on the inspectors calendar. Verification of the inspection is emailed to you, and the results can be followed on the "view my activity" section of the website.

Inspection of Properties and Home Remodeling

The Michigan State Tax Commission is responsible for setting guidelines for Township and City Assessment Administrators. Recently, the Tax Commission issued bulletins regarding the inspection of properties, and home remodeling. Regarding inspections, the bulletin state that municipalities must have a documented inspection plan that provides for consistent review of all properties within a specified period of time. Delta Township has developed a plan where each property is field reviewed approximately every

five years. Regarding home improvements, the bulletin outlines the process where assessors shall not consider the increase in value, that is the result of expenditures for normal repairs and maintenance until the property is sold. Delta Township has developed a system where these types of improvements are documented, and the contributory value is not added to the assessment roll as defined by law. This is known as the Mathieu-Gast Act.

School Bus Safety

It is time for our children to go back to school! Please review these important safety rules with your children.

- Be at the bus stop early. The bus driver may not see you running for the bus if you are late; you could slip and fall under the wheels.
- Wait for the bus in a safe place away from the road and the cars that are driving by. Stay back from the curb until the bus has come to a complete stop.
- Sit down as soon as possible. There may be other people waiting to get on, and if it takes too long for everyone to get on the bus other drivers may get impatient and go around the bus. Someone could get hit if this happens.
- Stay seated at all times, "back to back" and "bottom to bottom." Take off your backpack and put it in your lap.
- Keep your hands, arms, and head inside the bus at all times. A bus is wider than a car; it gets very close to trees and poles and you could be seriously injured if you have any body parts outside the bus.
- Please don't eat or drink on the bus. You could choke on the food and the driver may not see you.

- Listen to the bus driver and follow directions. The bus driver's instructions are for your safety.
- Leave the bus carefully, using the handrail so you won't fall.
- Take 10 giant steps past the front of the bus before crossing in front of it. You should be able to see the driver's face. Remember, if you can't see his face he can't see you.
- Wait for the bus driver's signal telling you it is safe to cross the road.
- You should always look LEFT, RIGHT, LEFT before crossing the road. The driver may not see everything.
- Stay away from the bus if you drop or forget something. NEVER go back to pick up something in the road; get an adult to get it for you. If you forgot something on the bus, you can always get it later. The bus driver can't see you if you are too close to the bus.

preparedness program, which focuses on a different area of emergency preparedness each month. Emergency preparedness doesn't have to be hard or expensive. If you follow along for an entire year, you will be better prepared to handle most disasters and emergencies. You can jump in anytime, and you don't have to do things in any order. 
