Electronics/Freon Collection

The Township offers a monthly (Saturday) event for electronics and Freon recycling. **A fee of .25 cents per pound will be charged for electronics and a fee of \$15.00 each will be charged for Freon containing items.** Examples of electronics include PCs, laptops, servers, printers, copiers, scanners, LCD screens, plasma/LED/flat screens, CRT monitors, CRT TVs, projection monitor/TVs, cell phones, answering machines, kitchen appliances, remote controlled items, or anything with a cord. Collection of these items will take place between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on the following dates:

August 20

October - No event due to deleafing

September 17

November 19

December 17

YARD WASTE

DELTA TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS ONLY

Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings, brush, twigs and branches. Branches must be shorter than 4' in length and smaller than 4" in diameter.

Yard waste may be transported in paper bags, cardboard boxes, plastic tubs or bundled. With the exception of paper yard waste bags, containers must be dumped. Township staff may not always be available to assist residents.

NO PLASTIC BAGS ARE PERMITTED!

VEHICLES

Based on Average Approximate Depth

S10 Pickup—\$12 level load (1.4 cubic yard)

Full Size Pickup—\$23 level load (2.7 cubic yard)

Mini Van w/open back—\$8.50 per foot (1 cubic yard)

TRAILERS

4' x 6' - \$6.00 per foot (.9 cubic yard/foot)

4' x 8' - \$8.00 per foot (1.2 cubic yard/foot)

5' x 8' - \$10.00 per foot (1.5 cubic yard/foot)

6' x 10' - \$15.00 per foot (2.2 cubic yard/foot)

30-gallon paper yard waste bags are available for purchase at the Recycling Center for \$3.00 for 5 bags.

Collection bins for eyeglasses and hearing aids have been added to the Recycling Center. A collection bin for eyeglasses is also available at the Township Administration Building located at 7710 W. Saginaw Highway.

Accepted Items

In general, Delta Township Recycling accepts plastics #1-#7, metals, clear & brown glass (no green, blue, frosted, plate, or sheet glass), paper, boxboard, polystyrene, bicycles, ink cartridges, CFL bulbs, household batteries, phone books, cell phones & cooking oil all year. **Pop or beer box containers, containers designed to go in the freezer or refrigerator, or plastic containers that hazardous waste comes in such as motor oil or anti-freeze for example, are not accepted. Plastic shopping bags or any other type of plastic bags are not accepted.**

Metal Collection: includes metal items such as washers, dryers, cook stoves, metal microwaves, water heaters, water softeners, furnaces, metal lawn furniture, lawn mowers (no fluids), rototillers, weed whackers, pots, pans, grills, basketball poles (no cement), metal fence bundled, cabinets & shelves, metal yard ornaments, clean burning barrels, steel doors (no glass), cast iron, metal sinks, etc. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE 80% METAL OR MORE TO BE ACCEPTED.** The metal collection is available all year at no cost.

Directions

The Recycling Center is located at 5717 Millett Hwy.

If you are traveling to the facility from Saginaw Highway, go south on Elmwood Road (by Meijer); Elmwood Road will change its name to Snow Road by the Waverly High School. Continue south past Mt. Hope Highway. Turn right on Pierson Highway; turn left on Sanders Road. Sanders Road ends at Millett Highway where the Recycling Center is located.

If you are traveling to the facility from Waverly Road, travel South on Waverly Road until reaching Lansing Road. Travel West on Lansing Road until reaching Millett Highway. The Recycling Center is located just across the railroad tracks on the south side of Millett Highway.
