

## Electronics/Freon Collection

The recycling center accepts electronics and all Freon containing appliances during regular hours of operation. Items accepted include but are not limited to: computers, printers, flat screen monitors, keyboards, fax machines, video cassette recorders, digital music and video players, video game consoles, small scale servers and scanners, cable receivers, satellite receivers, and flat screen televisions. The Recycling Center no longer accepts CRT's (Cathode Ray Tube) televisions and computer monitors. CRT's are the "old style" televisions and computer desk monitors. Look for future information through Delta Township, Eaton County, or Metro Lansing area for alternative events to recycle CRTs. Freon containing appliances include refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners and the like. All items are accepted at no cost.

## Controlled Substance Disposal

Drop boxes for unused controlled substances (pain relievers, anti-depressants, sleep aids, behavior modifications medication and illegal drugs) are available in the main lobby of the Eaton County Courthouse at 1045 Independence Blvd., Charlotte and at the Eaton County Sheriff's Office Delta Township Patrol located at 7108 Administration Dr., Lansing Monday thru Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. For more information on proper disposal, please visit the website at [www.takebackmeds.org](http://www.takebackmeds.org).

# Accepted Items

In general, Delta Township Recycling accepts plastics #1-#7, metals, clear & brown glass (no green, blue, or frosted), paper, boxboard, polystyrene, bicycles, ink cartridges, CFL bulbs, household batteries, phone books, cell phones & cooking oil all year. **Pop or beer box containers, containers designed to go in the freezer or refrigerator, or plastic containers that hazardous waste comes in such as motor oil or anti-freeze for example, are not accepted. Plastic shopping bags or any other type of plastic bags are not accepted.**

**Metal Collection:** includes metal items such as washers, dryers, cook stoves, metal microwaves, water heaters, water softeners, furnaces, metal lawn furniture, lawn mowers (no fluids), rototillers, weed whackers, pots, pans, grills, basketball poles (no cement), metal fence bundled, cabinets & shelves, metal yard ornaments, clean burning barrels, steel doors (no glass), cast iron, metal sinks, etc. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE 80% METAL OR MORE TO BE ACCEPTED.** The metal collection is available all year at no cost.

## Directions

The Recycling Center is located at 5717 Millett Hwy.

If you are traveling to the facility from Saginaw Highway, go south on Elmwood Road (by Meijer); Elmwood Road will change its name to Snow Road by the Waverly High School. Continue south past Mt. Hope Highway. Turn right on Pierson Highway; turn left on Sanders Road. Sanders Road ends at Millett Highway where the Recycling Center is located.

If you are traveling to the facility from Waverly Road, travel South on Waverly Road until reaching Lansing Road. Travel West on Lansing Road until reaching Millett Highway. The Recycling Center is located just across the railroad tracks on the south side of Millett Highway.
