Electronics/Freon Collection

The Township offers a monthly (Saturday) event for electronics and Freon recycling. **A fee of .25 cents per pound will be charged for electronics and a fee of \$15.00 each will be charged for Freon containing items.** Examples of electronics include microwaves, PCs, laptops, servers, printers, copiers, scanners, LCD screens, plasma/LED/flat screens, CRT monitors, CRT TVs, projection monitor/TVs, cell phones, answering machines, kitchen appliances, remote controlled items, or anything with a cord. Collection of these items will take place between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on the following dates:

March 18

April 22

May 13 (must register with Eaton County Resource Recovery. Delta Township's Recycling Center on Millett Hwy will be closed)

June 17

July 15

August 19

September 16

November 18

December 16

There will not be a collection in October

A fee of \$30.00 will be charged for the recycling of carbon monoxide and smoke detectors

The County will hold an event in May when carbon monoxide and smoke detectors will be taken for free under hazardous waste.

The DO'S and DON'TS of Battery Recycling

- **Do** follow the US Dept. of Transportation regulations and protect batteries from short circuiting by placing clear tape over the terminals. Batteries that do require tape are Lithium, Lithium Ion, and any other chemistry over 9 volts.
- **Don't** use colored, electrical, or masking tape on the terminals which hides battery identification information.
- **Don't** use plastic bags which result in greater waste and expense.

Accepted Items

In general, Delta Township Recycling accepts plastics #1-#7, metals, clear & brown glass (no green, blue, or frosted), paper, boxboard, polystyrene, bicycles, ink cartridges, CFL bulbs, household batteries, phone books, cell phones & cooking oil all year. **Pop or beer box containers, containers designed to go in the freezer or refrigerator, or plastic containers that hazardous waste comes in such as motor oil or anti-freeze for example, are not accepted. Plastic shopping bags or any other type of plastic bags are not accepted.**

Metal Collection: includes metal items such as washers, dryers, cook stoves, water heaters, water softeners, furnaces, metal lawn furniture, lawn mowers (no fluids), rototillers, weed whackers, pots, pans, grills, basketball poles (no cement), metal fence bundled, cabinets & shelves, metal yard ornaments, clean burning barrels, steel doors (no glass), cast iron, metal sinks, etc. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE 80% METAL OR MORE TO BE ACCEPTED.** The metal collection is available all year at no cost.

Directions

The Recycling Center is located at 5717 Millett Hwy.

If you are traveling to the facility from Saginaw Highway, go south on Elmwood Road (by Meijer); Elmwood Road will change its name to Snow Road by the Waverly High School. Continue south past Mt. Hope Highway. Turn right on Pierson Highway; turn left on Sanders Road. Sanders Road ends at Millett Highway where the Recycling Center is located.

If you are traveling to the facility from Waverly Road, travel South on Waverly Road until reaching Lansing Road. Travel West on Lansing Road until reaching Millett Highway. The Recycling Center is located just across the railroad tracks on the south side of Millett Highway.
