The Manager's Office is accepting applications for this full-time position in the Wastewater Division of the Utilities Department.

Under the supervision of the deputy director, performs and supervises plant operation and the performance of specialized chemical, bacteriological, and physical tests and analyses of raw, partially treated, and treated wastewater and bi-products to ensure that the plant is operating efficiently and meets local, state, and federal requirements; plans, schedules, supervises, and participates in the repair and maintenance of a wide variety of specialized mechanical and electrical equipment including buildings and grounds maintenance; responsible for the solids thickening and de-watering operations; implements process changes and adjustments to improve plant operation and conformance.

Successful completion of two years post-secondary education with a degree in environmental sciences, mechanical repair, or related field is desired. An equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job may be substituted. Minimum five years' experience working in a utilities system operation is required. An equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job may be substituted. Requires a State of Michigan Class C Wastewater Treatment Operator's Certificate. Must possess a valid State of Michigan vehicle operator's license. Requires the ability to supervise others, schedule sampling and testing, complete state reports, and the like; requires familiarity with specialized wastewater treatment equipment and machinery; requires thorough knowledge of the local, state, and federal laws and regulations relating to specialized laboratory tests on wastewater.
