SCRAP METAL / FREON CONTAINING ITEMS: THE ITEMS WILL BE RECYCLED AFTER THE FREON IS EXTRACTED.

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES: ALL HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. **ALL LITHIUM BATTERIES & ANY BATTERIES OVER 9-VOLTS MUST HAVE THEIR CIRCUITS TAPED. NO BAGGIES ACCEPTED.**
