REMINDER: There are three ways to vote the partisan section of the ballot.

STRAIGHT TICKET: In the General Election, voters may vote a straight party ticket. Nothing further needs to be done in the partisan section. Then, vote the nonpartisan and proposal sections.

SPLIT TICKET: Voting a split ticket, a voter may vote a straight ticket **AND** vote for individual candidates of their choice. (The individual votes cast for candidates will supersede the straight party vote cast). Vote the remaining Nonpartisan and Proposal section of ballot.

MIXED TICKET: Vote for the individual candidates of your choice in each office and on the nonpartisan and proposal section.

**COUNTY PROPOSAL
EATON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (EATRAN) MILLAGE RENEWAL
AUTHORIZATION QUESTION**

For the purpose of providing funds for the exclusive use of public transportation purposes, to include accommodation for the elderly and handicapped by the Eaton County Transportation Authority (EATRAN), at the same millage level previously approved by the voters in 2012, shall the previously voted increase in the constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Eaton, Michigan, be continued and renewed at up to 0.2500 of a mill (\$0.25 on each \$1,000 dollars of taxable value) for a period of five (5) years, 2017 to 2021, inclusive, and shall the County of Eaton be authorized to levy such millage for said purposes?

The estimate of the revenue for the County of Eaton in the 2017 calendar year is approximately \$851,100. A small portion of the revenue collected (approximately \$11,709 in 2017) may be required to be distributed to Downtown Development Authorities, Tax Increment Financing Authorities, Local Development Financing Authorities and Brownfield Redevelopment Financing Authorities established in cities of Charlotte, Eaton Rapids, Grand Ledge, Potterville & Village of Bellevue.

THE POLLS will be open at 7 o'clock a.m. and will remain open until 8 o'clock p.m. To see if you are registered to vote check the Secretary of State Voter Information web site at www.michigan.gov/vote.

Photo Identification OR Affidavit Required to Vote:

Under a Michigan law passed and upheld by the Michigan Supreme Court, ALL voters will be asked to show photo identification to vote at the polls. Voters without identification will be required to fill out and sign an affidavit of identity in order to receive a ballot.

Applications for absentee ballots are available in the Clerk's Office. Voters who are 60 years of age or over, physically challenged, or anticipate they will be out of the Township on Election Day are eligible to apply. Call the Clerk's Office at 323-8500 to request an application for an absentee ballot. In addition to our regular hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, the Clerk's Office will be open on Saturday, October 29, 2016, 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 2, 2016, 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m., Saturday, November 5, 2016, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., and Sunday, November 6, 2016, from 12:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m., for the purpose of processing Absentee Ballot Applications and ballots.

Monday, November 7th at 4:00 p.m. is the deadline to request an absentee ballot. Ballots requested on Sunday, November 6, and Monday, November 7, 2016, must be requested and voted in person at the Delta Township Clerk's Office at 7710 W. Saginaw Highway, Lansing.

All precincts are handicap accessible and instructions in alternative formats of audio and braille are available at all precincts upon request. An accessible voting device is also available.
