MAKING PROGRESS: STORMWATER DISCHARGE PERMITS ISSUED FOR THE CITY OF EAST LANSING AND MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY

All GLRC members have been working hard to put the final touches on their stormwater permit applications, originally submitted to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) in early 2013. The first two of sixteen total applications were issued on April 15, 2015. [The City of East Lansing](#) and [Michigan State University](#) stormwater discharge

permits will become effective June 1, 2015. The GLRC looks forward to continued implementation activities and working hard to reduce pollution through stormwater management.
